Instructor's Comments: Astar means travel or journey in the gaelic language and the plaits here are travelling around each other which was one reason I chose this title but Astar has another meaning for me but you will need to be in the class to find that one out.

Size of Project: 9" x 5"

Skill level : Open

Pre-requisites: None

What will be taught in class

Five straw flat plait – checkerboard
Joining straws and turning a corner
2 Straw plait
Forming a celtic knot

What needs to be done before coming to class:

Suggested Wheat: Fine to medium thick wheat

Straws needed: 25-30 straws, 16-18" long, fine to medium thickness, more straws if they are shorter.

Other supplies by instructor: n/a

Supplies to bring: Strong thread, scissors, ruler, 2 straw beads (I will bring if you don't have any). Glue to glue the beads in place, I use a glue gel. Florist wire 18 guage 8 inches in length, pin board and pins
