Pre-requisites: Prepare straw ribbons. Helpful to know rustic plait

What will be taught in class: Belarusian techniques Elements shown in thumbnail pictures here.



What needs to be done before coming to class: Prepare straw ribbons

Suggested Wheat: Soft wide wheat or rye straw

Straws needed: About 35 first joint straws 12"
30 second joint straws (all should be soaked and ready to go)

Other supplies by instructor: *Rye and Barely straw from Belarus, *base for a bell

Supplies to bring: light green thread, straw colored thread, glue, thin copper wire, scissors, 5-10 pieces of straw threads, glue brush, needle for sewing
