Instructor's Comments: This project is very laborious, requires patience, precision and accuracy in execution

Size of Project: 2 ¾" x 2 ¼"

Skill level : Intermediate

Pre-requisites: Prepare straw ribbons.

What will be taught in class: The techniques of decorating Easter eggs made of wood. (special technology). How to prepare the egg will be discussed, but one will be provided, ready to use.



What needs to be done before coming to class: Prepare straw ribbons

Suggested Wheat: Soft wide wheat or rye straw

Straws needed: About 30 second joint straws 8" long, natural and two shades of yellow

Other supplies by instructor : *Rye and Barely straw from Belarus, * special knife tool (made in Belarus), *wooden egg (covered with special composition)

Supplies to bring: A cutting mat, glue brush, sponge for water, a tea towel and small bowl to set egg in while working
