Instructor's Comments: Since the State flower of Indiana is the peony and I have always liked peonies it was a challenge to make one "blossom" for the straw convention. I also find pop up cards challenging to design the surprise inside when one opens the card.

Size of Project: 6" x 4 ½" x 1/8"

Skill level : open

Pre-requisites: none

What will be taught in class : Basic marquetry and how to design a pop up card

What needs to be done before coming to class: N/A

Suggested Wheat: N/A

Straws needed: You may bring colored straws of your choice or it can also be done in all natural straw.

10 – 15 straws 8" to 10" long red or choice

5 straws 8" – 10" long green or choice

1 straw 8" – 10" natural straw

Supplies to bring: Hinderburg or knife to scrape pith of the straw, good scissors, glue, thread, compass for circles, ruler, 3 sheets about 9" x 12" manila tag paper (cardstock), 2 sheets about 9" x 12" paper to match flower straw color, needle and thread to match flower color.

Instructor note: I will bring a petal tracer to share and red thread and a needle to share. I will demo with natural straw in the class. Call me if you have a question.
