Size of Project: 15-18" long

Skill level : intermediate

Pre-requisites: Prepare straw ribbons, helpful to know rustic plait

What will be taught in class Belarusian open petal.

What needs to be done before coming to class: Prepare 10 pieces of Swiss straw threads

Suggested Wheat: Soft wide wheat or rye

Straws needed: 65 first joint straws, 15-20 " long, 25 barley 4-7" long, 35 second joint straws, 14-16" long, all straws should be soaked and ready to go.

Other supplies by instructor : *straw and *stems for flowers

Supplies to bring: glue, thread, scissors, wire stems, thin copper wire

Materials Kit: It is Raisa's intention to provide Rye straw for class, however her straw may not be permitted to enter the US, so be prepared by bringing your own wheat straw as a backup.
