Size of Project: 9" x 8" x 1/2"

Skill level: intermediate and advanced

Pre-requisites: Flat plait, flat foot rustic, 4 straw whip, 3 straw braid, locking straws, tying

on a plane

What will be taught in class All the above will be reviewed and taught as necessary.

What needs to be done before coming to class: nothing

Suggested Wheat: Any pliable wheat will do

Straws needed: 20 straws 18-24" (thick), 10 straws 20" (fine), 3 straws 20" (thick), 4 straws 18-20" (fine), 20 straws 6" (thick), noded 6 big and 6 small, 20 straws 20" or longer (thick) open and flattened beforehand.

Other supplies by instructor: n/a

Supplies to bring: glue, thread, scissors, hindenberg or knife, 1" wooden bead, 10 grocery ties. 13 Job's tears or similar sized beads, needle and thread to string them.
