Skill Level: Intermediate

Size of Project: 12"x8"x1"

Techniques: Finchingfield Diamond Plait, Arrow Plait, 2-straw plait, Checkerboard Flower Petal, spreuer

Suggested Wheat: (soaked before class)
Any kind of wheat you are comfortable working with.

Straws Needed:

26 straws 13" with matching heads for Finchingfield plait

1 long fat straw 18" without head for spreuers. This straw will be split.

40 straws 10" without heads for the remainder of the project.

Other Supplies: thread, scissors, straw splitter, straw scraper (Hindenburg), 4" of 20 gauge wire, pinning board and pins, hot glue (teacher will provide)
