

DIAMOND GOD'S EYE ©2004

Class 13, Session E, Saturday, 8:00-11:30

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Skill Level: Intermediate

Size of Project: 6" W x 10" L not including beards

Techniques: 4 sided God's Eye, adding a bead and changing the shape from a square to a diamond God's Eye, using corn husks to help reinforce the back of the God's Eye, 1 or 2 straw rose, twisted rope plait



Suggested Wheat: Black bearded wheat and ND Blackberry wheat were used for the convention project. You need the longer heads and straw that I've listed if you choose to use Kansas winter wheat.

I suggest using whatever straw you are comfortable working with.

Straws Needed:

- 12-straws for twisted rope plaits, 2 ½"+ heads, 15" straw length;
- approximately 20+ medium small straws, 12" + long, no heads, for making the God's Eye
- straws for straw rose

Other Supplies: Gold bead, 1-6" and 1-8" piece of 18 gauge wire, cornhusks (2 pieces, 5" long and 2" wide), 36" of colored raffia, 2 clothespins, tension tool and clamps, ruler, wire cutter, tacky glue, hot glue, several pieces of natural raffia for tying, tension tool and clamps

Materials Kit: Cost: \$6.00

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Kits are required if offered. Kit includes: gold bead, 2 pieces of #18 gauge wire, cornhusks, colored raffia, straw for 1 or 2 straw rose, natural raffia

I will have my tension tool in class but will be unable to bring extra. If you have your own, please bring it to class. My tension tool will be available for use in class.

I have other raffia colors available if you do not want red. They are medium blue, dark blue, leaf green, hunter green, burgundy, gold, peach, black. Please let me know by April 8th if you want a different color. I will bring red for the class kits unless contacted.

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
