**Instructor's Comments:** I chose to teach a beginner plait class using different plaits with 5 straws. Rather than just teach the plaits, we will be putting them together in a favor.

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Size of Project:** 9" x 3" x 1"

**Techniques:** 5-straw round, 5-straw Dunstable distorted, zig-zag with 2 floaters, spiral with center core, spiral without a core.

**Suggested Wheat:** Any wheat that you like to work with will be okay. I have chosen to use beardless.

## **Straws Needed:**

15 straws with heads 14" long for core and sides of favor

5 straws without heads 12" for decorative cap

5 straws without heads 15" long for flower

5 very fine straws without heads 10" long for hanger

**Other Supplies:** thread, scissors, pinning board and pins, 1 piece of #20 gauge wire 6" long, 10" of ribbon your choice of color.
