Techniques Taught in Class:

Students will learn Belarusian techniques to weave different elements, as well as a two-sided leaf, and how to put them together to finish the project. Depending on student's ability, training, and speed, options are provided.

Straws Needed:

*Rye straw: 70 pieces. Approximately 50 straws should be from the first joint 20-24 inches long.

Supplies Needed:

General wheat weaving supplies; Swiss straw threads; PVA glue and glue brush.

*Piece of ribbon for bow

Kit: \$12.00 - contains all starred (*) items in Straws and Supplies lists.

Available for Purchase:

Raisa has a particular knife that she uses to cut the rye straw. The knife has a wooden handle and a ½" blade, which is set at an angle that cuts the straw precisely. You can use an Exacto knife with some success. Cost of the knife is \$20.00.
