+Watercolor set with brush; +Permanent markers (brown, red, green, black); +Small flat brush 1/4" wide; +Large flat brush 2" -3" wide

*5" x 7" foam board; *5" x 7" fabric the color of evening sky; *Wheat paper; *2 patterns; *Wax paper; *Tooth picks; *Fabric paste
