When I heard the theme for this convention was weaving friendships, I thought of the friendship bracelets that teenagers like to make with embroidery floss and, more recently, with paracord. I have provided several variations using straw instead of floss.

## Techniques Taught in Class:

4-straw Whip Plait; 5-straw Flat Checkerboard; 4-straw Round.

## Straws Needed:

*4 large diameter rye or wheat straws in different coordinating colors $18+$ inches long for each bracelet.

## Supplies Needed:

General wheat weaving supplies; 6-fin straw splitter; Needle nose pliers; Jewelry glue.
*Jewelry clasp of your choice; *Two $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ jewelry bars (for flat bracelet);
*Two $1 / 4$ " bars (for round bracelet); *Two jump rings for each bracelet.
