Other Supplies Needed

- Quick grab tacky glue
- Hot glue
- ♦ 3 needle tool, needles 1/8" apart
- Dog tooth comb
- Needle nose pliers
- Fat needle to make bulrushes (rattenchegel)

Class Kit:

- 8 colored straw splits for dragonfly and butterfly (I will have other colors available)
- 8 natural colored straw splits
- 2-3" grapevine wreaths
- 26 straw threads
- 3-2" pieces of straw for bulrushes
- Open eve needle for threading beads onto larger horseshoes
- I will have assorted 6-8 mm beads to choose from, for larger horseshoes

- Curly spreuer
- Veined leaf spreuer
- Wantele
- Rattenchegel (Bulrush)
- 3 needle rose
- 2 needle daisy
- Looped needle rose (half hitch with loops)

- How to tie a Swiss Lace weaver's knot.
- Must have some experience in making Swiss Lace, **NOT** a beginner's class.
